- 1. We are active citizens with the will to form a progressive political space that significantly influences the course of our country.
- 2. We are Cypriots, and we are Europeans. We want to shape common positions for all countries and the governance system in the European Union.
- 3. We love Europe; it is our home, but this does not mean that there is no room for improvement.
- 4. We envision a strong and just Europe for all, regardless of their religion, origin, social and economic status, sexual orientation, or gender identity.
- 5. We feel that the fight against xenophobia, discrimination, and unequal development is our obligation.
- 6. We know that many of today's problems we face, perhaps the most significant, have no borders, and cannot be approached comprehensively at the national level.
- 7. Climate change, global immigration, racism, and the visible threat to global peace, require the cooperation of all European citizens.
- 8. The pan-European platform of Volt Europa ensures that these challenges will be addressed with a unified program and design, resulting from collectivity, mutual understanding, and collaboration.
- 9. Volt Cyprus (Volt Kibris Βολτ Κύπρος), an equal and active member of Volt Europa, is here to express the social movement and political trend for significant change!

- 16. Our schools are unable to prepare young citizens for the real needs of the modern era.
- 17. Nationalism, populism, corruption, and tolerance dominate the public sphere.
- 18.As a result, citizens undervalue democratic processes, the prospect of resolving the Cyprus problem, and the importance of the European Union.
- 19. There are forces and powerful interests in both communities that benefit from division and corruption, invest in the status quo, and perpetuate the "law of necessity."
- 20.It's time to tell them, "enough!" Cyprus deserves better, and we have a different plan for our country.
- 21. Volt aspires to connect the federal perspective of Europe with the federal perspective for our country.
- 22. We believe that federalism can provide answers to the major challenges facing both Cyprus and the European Union.
- 23. Together and united, we can determine the fate of our island and our European family.
- 24. Europe can offer Cyprus ideas, expertise, and comprehensive support based on its own historical processes of unification.
- 25. Our country, in turn, has the opportunity and the potential to provide Europe with an example of multicultural coexistence and cooperation, despite the complex situation and difficulties faced on the island.
